NOTE 1: STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

a. The Committee has determined that Broome Turf Club Incorporated is not a reporting entity and as such has an exemption from income tax from the Australian Taxation Office. This special purpose financial report has been prepared in order to fulfil the Committees' financial reporting requirements under the Broome Turf Club Incorporated Constitution and the Associations Incorporation Act (WA). Please note, that In order to align the reporting period with the race season, the 2016 financial year extended for 13 months from 1 August 2015 to 31 August 2016, whereas the 2017 financial period onward extends for 12 months from 1 September 2016 to 31 August.

The financial report has been prepared in accordance with the requirements of the Australian Accounting Standards including AASB1031 Materiality and AASB110 Events after Balance Sheet Date. The financial report is prepared on an accruals basis and is based on historic costs, except where specifically stated.

b. Basis of Going Concern

The Committee has resolved after reviewing the financial result for the previous year, the cashflow budget for the ensuing year, and considering increased cash flow opportunities though stricter money handling controls and reduction in variable outgoings, that Broome Turf Club Incorporated will be able to pays its debts as and when they fall due and will continue in operation for the forseeable future.

The following specific accounting policies, which are consistent with the previous period unless otherwise stated, have been adopted in the preparation of this report:

c. Property, Plant and Equipment

Property, plant and equipment are carried at cost or independent valuation. All assets, excluding freehold land and buildings, are depreciated over their useful lives. An independent valuer will be engaged in the 2018 FY to review all assets with the aim to validify and value all assets held.

d. Inventories

Inventories are measured at cost. Costs are assigned on a first-in first-out basis.

e. Employee Entitlements

Provision has been made for annual leave liability accrued at balance date. Annual leave is expected to be settled within 12 months and has been measured at nominal value.

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INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT TO THE MEMBERS OF THE MEMBERS OF BROOME TURF CLUB INC.

Qualified Opinion

We have audited the financial report of Broome Turf Club Inc. (the Club), which comprises the statement of financial position as at 31 August 2017, the statement of profit or loss and the statement of changes in equity for the year then ended, and notes to the financial statements, including a summary of significant accounting policies, and the declaration by those charged with governance.

In our opinion, except for the effects of the matter described in the Basis for Qualified Opinion section of our report, the accompanying financial report gives a true and fair view of the financial position of Broome Turf Club Inc. as at 31 August 2017, and of its financial performance for the year then ended in accordance with the Associations Incorporation Act (Western Australia) 2015 and the accounting policies described in Note 1 to the financial statements.

Basis for Qualified Opinion

Comparatives - Opening balances as at 1 September 2016 (and prior year balances as at 31 August 2016)
As the incoming auditor we have been unable to obtain sufficient evidence regarding the comparatives, and the current audit report is qualified on the basis of this scope limitation.

Property, plant and equipment as at 31 August 2017

There was insufficient evidence to support whether the assets listed on the Broome Turf Club Inc. fixed asset register as at 31 August 2017 of \$2,659,215 existed, were valued correctly and was in working order. This qualification extends to the associated depreciation expense for the year ended 31 August 2017 of \$190,518.

Cash receipts - race day takings

As is common for organisations of this type, it is not practicable for the Club to maintain an effective system of internal control over cash receipts, specifically the race day takings. Accordingly, our audit in relation to income was limited to amounts recorded in the financial records.

We conducted our audit in accordance with Australian Auditing Standards. Our responsibilities under those standards are further described in the *Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Report* section of our report. We are independent of Broome Turf Club Inc. in accordance with the ethical requirements of the Accounting Professional and Ethical Standards Board's APES 110 *Code of Ethics for Professional Accountants* (the Code) that are relevant to our audit of the financial report in Australia. We have also fulfilled our other ethical responsibilities in accordance with the Code.

We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our qualified opinion.

Emphasis of Matter – Going Concern

We draw attention to Note 1(b) to the financial statements which outlines that the Broome Turf Club Inc. Committee has resolved after reviewing the financial result for the previous year, and the cash flow budget for the ensuing year and considering the increased cash flow opportunities through stricter money handling controls and reduction in variable outgoings, that Broome Turf Club will be able to pay its debts as and when they fall due, and will continue in operation for the foreseeable future.

Basis of Accounting

We draw attention to Note 1 to the financial report, which describes the basis of accounting. The financial report has been prepared to assist the Broome Turf Club Inc. to meet the requirements of the Associations Incorporation Act (Western Australia) 2015. As a result, the financial report may not be suitable for another purpose. Our opinion is not modified in respect of this matter.

Responsibilities of Management and Those Charged with Governance for the Financial Report

Management is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of the financial report in accordance with the financial reporting requirements of the *Associations Incorporation Act (Western Australia) 2015* and for such internal control as management determine is necessary to enable the preparation of the financial report that is free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

In preparing the financial report, management are responsible for assessing the Broome Turf Club Inc. ability to continue as a going concern, disclosing, as applicable, matters relating to going concern and using the going concern basis of accounting unless management either intend to liquidate the Broome Turf Club Inc. or to cease operations, or has no realistic alternative but to do so.

Those charged with governance are responsible for overseeing the Broome Turf Club Inc. financial reporting process.

Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Report
